Eastern Europe

After decades of atheism many people in Eastern Europe are searching for meaning and finding it in Jesus Christ.

Good News Service In October 2004 Julie and I were returning from a mission trip in India, transferring in the Schipol airport in Amsterdam. As we were waiting to board the plane in Amsterdam we struck up a conversation with a Dutch gentleman and his wife who were making a yearly trip to the United States. In our discussion I learned that this man, Jan Peterse, was the leader of a Christian mission distributing Bibles into Eastern Europe. He told me he was led to the Lord many years ago in a restaurant by Corrie Ten Boom, the well-known rescuer of Jews in Holland during World War II. During the cold war Jan

worked with Brother Andrew smuggling Bibles into eastern Europe.

Jan and Eefje Peterse lead the organization Good News Service which is based in both the Netherlands and the United States. Each year for the past 12 years Jan has asked me to attend the board meeting here in the United States. Until this year I could not find my way clear to attend, but this year

we did. It was a joy to see Jan and Eefje again and meet some of the dedicated members of the board. We had a wonderful time in fellowship and getting to know the work of Good News Service much better.

As you know, Eastern Europe has been dominated for decades by atheistic communism. Now that most of the countries have achieved their own governments and democracies there is also more freedom of worship. Many are receiving Jesus Christ for the first time!

Each year in the summer they hold a number of youth Bible camps. Children and teenagers hear the message of the gospel, usually for the first time. On average 70% make a commitment to Jesus Christ. The large camp is in western Ukraine, and a smaller one also in the very poor country of Moldova.



In fact Moldova is the poorest country in Europe. It is so poor that when children grow up, over 50% of them leave the country to find employment in various places all over the world: Europe, Australia, Southeast Asia, Israel and many other portions of the world. So when young

people receive Jesus Christ as Savior in a Bible camp in Moldova, many will be scattered and some will become evangelists all over the world. This is truly a strategic opportunity to spread the gospel at relatively low cost. Just like Christ in You, 100% of contributions to Good News Service goes to the gospel ministry.
