# FEATURES:

To achieve these goals and objectives with efficiency and precision, the activities of the college has been divided into three separate components.

# 1. Spiritual Life

Trinity Baptist Church, the sponsoring church provides students a warm local church atmosphere and care. Involvement in the church acquaints students and staff with the working of a biblical church and encourages them in their service for the Lord and the church.

# 2. Academic Commitment

Our dedicated and qualified teachers are committed to motivating the students and creating an atmosphere of common commitment to academic excellence. Our classes, with a student-faculty ratio of 10 to 1 will enable teachers to give students individual attention and care. In addition to prescribed

curriculum, caring and loving faculty members are committed to meeting the spiritual needs of their students and encourage them to model a good Christian.

The co-curriculum of the college helps in developing a well-rounded personality for students. Planned activities include Bible class, Church music, athletics, vocational training and career guidance.

#### 3. Standards of Conduct

The college is committed to the highest standards of Christian conduct and holds that the Bible, the infallible, the divine Word of God provides the basis for that conduct. The college has adopted these biblical standards in order to provide an environment conducive for the spiritual growth and maturity of its students.

#### LOCATION

The college is located outside Imphal but easily accessible by thirty minute drive from Imphal and ten minute drive from National Highway-2. The campus occupies a scenic area of more than 100 acres. It is located between Leimakhong army cantonement and Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Makhan. Our location provides a safe and ideal campus for students seeking to pursue higher studies from a Christian atmosphere. Heritage is the perfect place to experience college life and spiritual growth.

#### UNIQUENESS OF HERITAGE CHRISTIAN COLLEGE

The college which is the only one of its kind in the whole state of Manipur will also compete with the rest of 43 colleges in the state.

Unlike other government (Hindus) and Roman Catholic colleges, Heritage is committed to propagate the Christian worldview and, as its prime goal, promote a true integration of faith and learning. This is in sharp contrast to that of other colleges in the state, and it will address the whole man-body, mind and spirit. Within this context, there will be several sub-goals that must be Christian perspective.

- 1. The college is philosophically centered on the Christian perspective.
- 2. A well-balanced academic program that prepare students for both secular and Christian service positions are provided.
- 3. Attention is given to both primary and proximate goals of Christian higher education, the primary goal being the preaching of the gospel of Christ to all nations, and the proximate, that men fulfil their responsibility to God and society in order to develop in their particular areas of giftedness.
- 4. A curricular program of academic excellence and research is made available to all students. Sound preparation in the liberal arts, which emphasizes broad areas of study in addition to specific skill development which is interwoven with sound scriptural principles are provided.
- 5. Students are always encouraged to prayerfully explore talents and to integrate their skills into their academic/personal/spiritual interests and calling of God.
- 6. Attention is given to the areas of thinking skills and communication skills. Reasoning and deductive skills, as well as spiritual discernment, is being taught.
- 7. Leadership behaviour and responsibility are always encouraged and rewarded. A well-grounded study of Christian principles and ethics, as they pertain to administrative leadership and servanthood are the basic part of the program.
- 8. Students are equipped to fulfil their obligations successfully in their

possessions; as spouses, parents, or single members of the Body of Christ; and as contributors to society, using a scriptural definition of success.

### MISSIONARY PROSPECT OF THE COLLEGE

Historical background:

The state of Manipur in Northeast India is located in a very strategic place for the Christian mission in this present age. Geographically, it lies at the foot of the Himalayan region, where neighbouring countries are closed to foreign missionaries. Some strategic unreached nations that can be easily reached from Manipur are Bhutan, Nepal and Sikkim to the northwest, Myanmar to the east and Bangladesh to the southwest. Bhutan is a Bhudhist nation that is categorized as an *extremely restricted* country for the gospel. Myanmar, a Bhudhist country, and Nepal, a Hindu country, are categorized as *highly restricted* countries for the gospel. Bangladesh, a Muslim country, and India, a Hindu country, are categorized as *moderately restricted* countries. The state of Manipur lies strategically among these countries.

Internally, the state of Manipur, like any other Indian state, is officially Hindu. The Meitei Hindus, which constitute about 70 percent of the total population in the state are categorized as an *Unreached People Group* in the World Missionary Survey and included in the *Least Reached People's List*. Out of 2 million Meitei Hindus, there are only about 2,000 baptized Christians among them.

The Christians and the Church in Manipur have a great responsibility for world mission and God has placed this state in a very strategic place and given them an opportunity to preach the Gospel in this region and to the whole world. Heritage Christian College and placed in this location for His glory.

Christianity in India is as old as the first apostolic Church because there is a tradition that Apostle Thomas came to India in the first century. It is agonizing to see that out of 1.2 billion people in India, hardly 3 percent are Christians. Out of this 3 percent, not even one percent is mission minded let alone evangelical. With the growth of population, Christianity is decreasing slowly. The need to reach the Gospel is great and urgent. If not now, when? If not we, who?

There are many mission agencies both national and foreign working in India and Manipur. But the result is very disappointing. Even though education played a very significant role in world mission, no church has really explored its significance and prospect in this part of the world at present time. Today almost every child is going to school and 70 percent of the total population are students. It is therefore greatly felt that students must reach the students. History tells us that education is one of the most powerful weapons the church has for the advancement of God's kingdom. College students are the ones who will carry the burden of the country and the church of tomorrow. College and university campuses are often birth places of mission movement and centers of mission activity. According to mission scholar Herbert Kane, there are three important movements in the history of Protestant missionary world: the Faith Mission Movement, Bible Institute Movement and Student Volunteer Movement

The foreign mission movement in America began in a Christian college. The famous "Haystack Prayer Meeting" on the campus of Williams College marks the real beginning of foreign mission work of America Churches. These first missionaries who went out were graduates of a Christian college. When the German church was losing its life, a student movement led to revival, which included the formation of the Moravian Church.

It is our prayer and passion that Heritage Christian College will be the place where God will help the Church in her mission to glorify God and fulfilling the mission of the Great Commission and the ministry of proclamation.

How will Heritage Prepares for World Mission?

1. Evangelizing the students

Every year, in Manipur alone, more than 40,000 young boys and girls enter into college. Many go to big cities such as New Delhi, Mumbai, Madras, and Kolkata and they are unprepared for the culture shock that they experience in the secular atmosphere of the university. As a result, many become indifferent toward the Church or permanently leave it. Those who do not afford to go to other cities have no other option but to go to Hindu (government) colleges or Christian colleges run by only Roman Catholics. The collegiate setting provides a unique atmosphere to facilitate evangelism. With prayer and all efforts, the college strives to present the gospel to non-Christians and help the Christian students to grow spiritually.

2. Character Building of the Students:

A consistently Christlike life is one of the most important factors in sharing the gospel with the Hindus. Christian character can be an effective form of cross-cultural witness in Indian context. Many parents sent their children to Heritage Christian College because of its standards of conduct and academic excellency.

3. Vitality of the Church's Own Life.

Educated church leaders are especially needed for times of renewal, and such is the need in India and Manipur today. One of the greatest weaknesses of the Christians in Manipur is their nominalism. The people who may be able to bring renewal to the churches in this condition include educated students, armed with knowledge and the zeal of youth on fire for Christ.

4. Equipping Church Leaders:

Leadership in the church is a crucial issue in the life of churches in India and Manipur. Churches need committed and qualified leaders. Heritage Christian College is committed to prepare and produce committed leaders in the church.

#### PRAY FOR US.

The Heritage Christian College is entering into the second year of its history. But the Lord is doing great things with us. The college that was built by God on faith has rooted into the deep soil and has branched into a fine young tree. What started with the single goal "Glory to God" has not only fulfilling its purpose, but also to something substantially and profoundly beyond that.

This could have never been possible without the prayer, moral and financial support of everyone involved- the students, the parents, the teachers and our Christian well-wishers. It is our pleasure and privilege to share some great news with you. 1. Enrolment: The college that begins with 63 students in its inaugural batch is now increased to 165. There are a good number of students from Hindus and Nepalis. 21 of the students are children of either pastor or missionary. 18 of the students are either orphans or school drop outs. We are giving them 30% concession of their fees. If there is no Heritage Christian College, they will not have opportunity to go for college studies or compel to attend Hindu and Roman Catholic institutions.

2. Affiliation and Recognization: The college is fully affiliated to Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur and recognized by the Government of Manipur. The inspection team of the Council graded the college as "Excellent."

3. Activities:

(a) Spiritual Development

We give spiritual growth of the students as our topmost priority. The day begins with devotion and ends with devotion. Chapel is the first period of the day's schedule.

- (b) Bible Classes: Every Saturday of the week is set aside for Bible Classes. Sunday School of not less than two hours is regularly maintained.
- (c) Church Music: Church Music is offered to interested students. At present 43 students are in the class
- (d) Mission Sunday and Prayer

First Sunday of every month is set aside as "Mission Sunday". Students have fasting program and the food we save on this day is set aside for Mission fund. At present, the college is sponsoring one missionary in Odisa. Staff and staff also go out for outreach mission occasionally.

We have always thrived for excellence and every student is an intrinsic part of our extended family. God has entrusted to us with more than hundred souls. We are committed to honour His trust. We pray and believe that each soul in the college will come to the saving knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and they will become His missionaries to the place where God placed them.
