**As we enter into a new year, we have many things that need to be done. Please pray for us. Our most urgent and greatest and immediate needs is:**

**A computer with printer and other accessories.**

**We are handicapped because of this problem. Provided we have this facility, we hope we can correspond more frequently.**

**Reasons: Typing and printing of all official documents, letters, etc.**

**Typing of all question papers for examinations**

**Photostate of certificates and other documents.**

## Repenting and Renewing



When I was visiting the home of our associate Simon Haqq in Delhi, India a few weeks ago, these two ladies were also guests in his home. They were in fact Simon's mother (on the left in the photo), and his aunt, (on the right in the photo). These sisters were a delight to visit.

His aunt shared with me a bit of her own walk with the Lord. She was married for 45 years when her husband became sick. She cared for him sacrificially for many months. When he died she became bitter at God. She admitted that until that point she had only been a nominal Christian.

One day after her husband's death she visited her sister (the person on the left) and she began to vent to her sister how she did not trust God anymore and how awful it was that God took her husband from her. Her sister held her hands to her ears and would not listen, in fact reprimanded her for speaking that way about God. Her sister took some oil to represent the Holy Spirit and placed it on her head and pray that God would forgive her.

Just then she became remorseful and cried. She repented to God for her lack of faith and unbelief. That was a turning point for her. She told me that since that day she developed a new love for God and she trusted Him. Even in her older years she became spiritually young and revitalized. She has had a heart of gratitude to God ever since.
