Thank you for your mail. We just returned from a mission to Northern Uganda. It was such a powerful mission. We visited two of our churches, one very recently started - Katulikire.

In one very special meeting we had an almost Pentecost experience in which we saw the Holy Spirit of God fall upon the entire congregation and everyone experience a baptism of the Holy Spirit.

We saw the new believers speak in tongues for so long enjoying the presence of God in so much that the pastors from the neighboring churches marveled.





I did send you the clips of the different pastors giving thanks for their piece of land that you helped buy them. May the Lord reward you exceedingly. I was able to get 3 of the six pastors since they come from different regions. But their overseer is seen thanking on the behalf of the three who were absent. But at the earliest, maybe by end month, when I get them I will ask them to testify.
