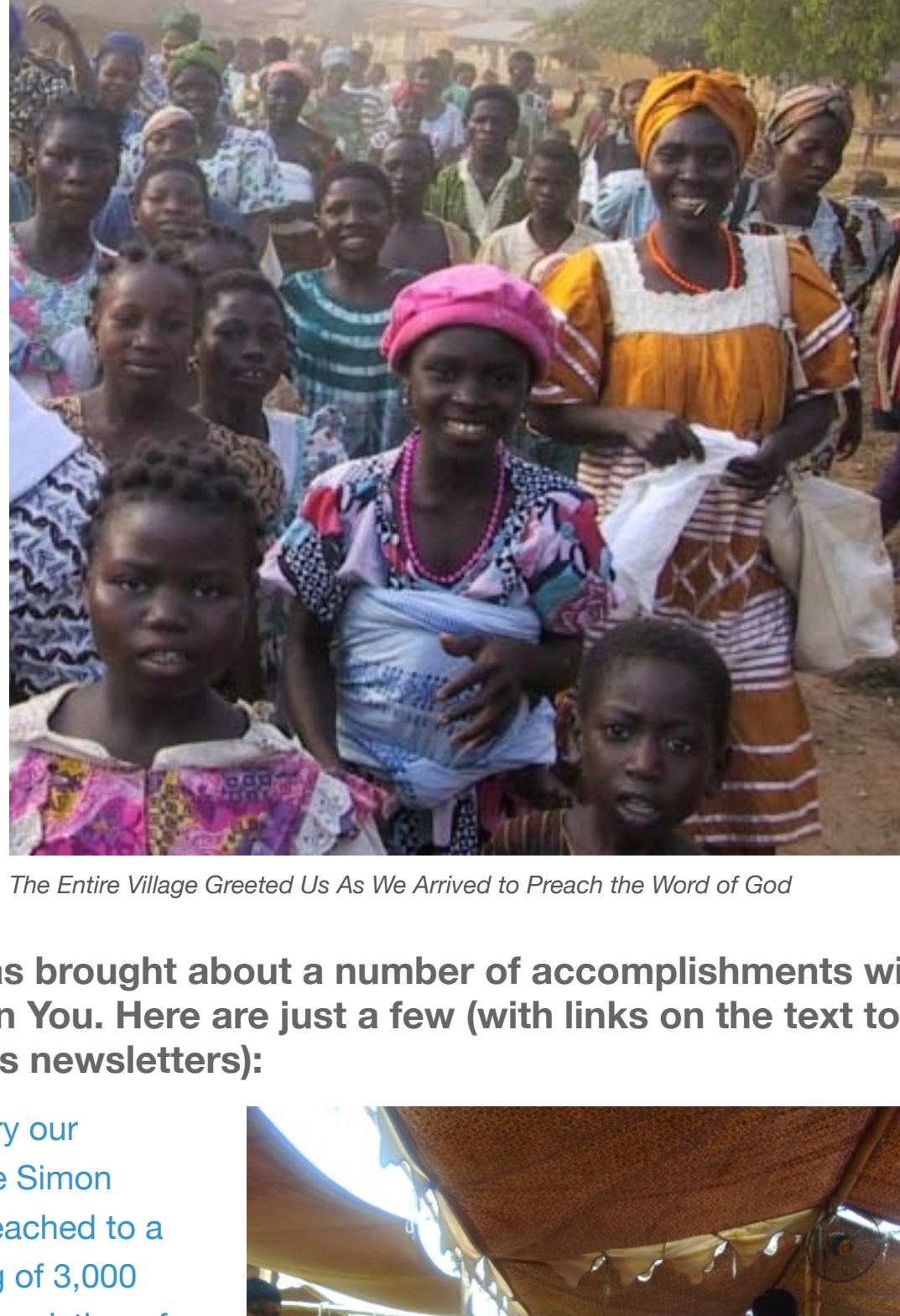

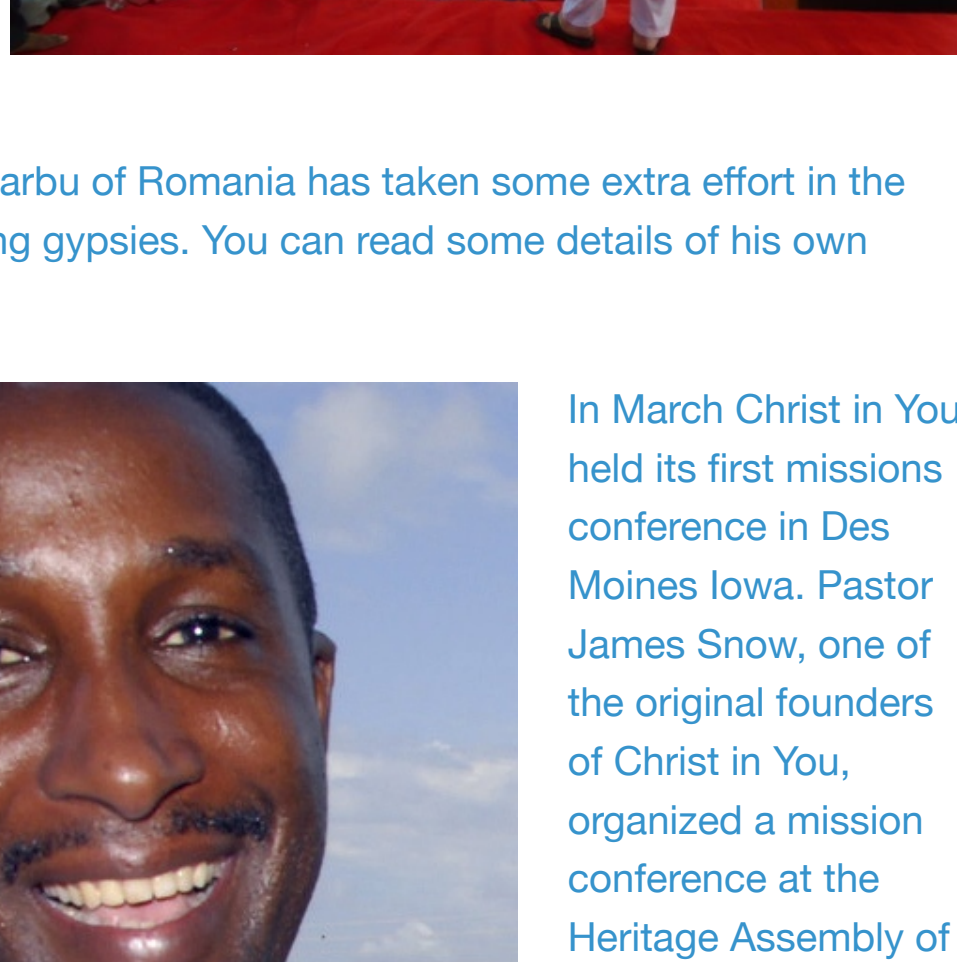

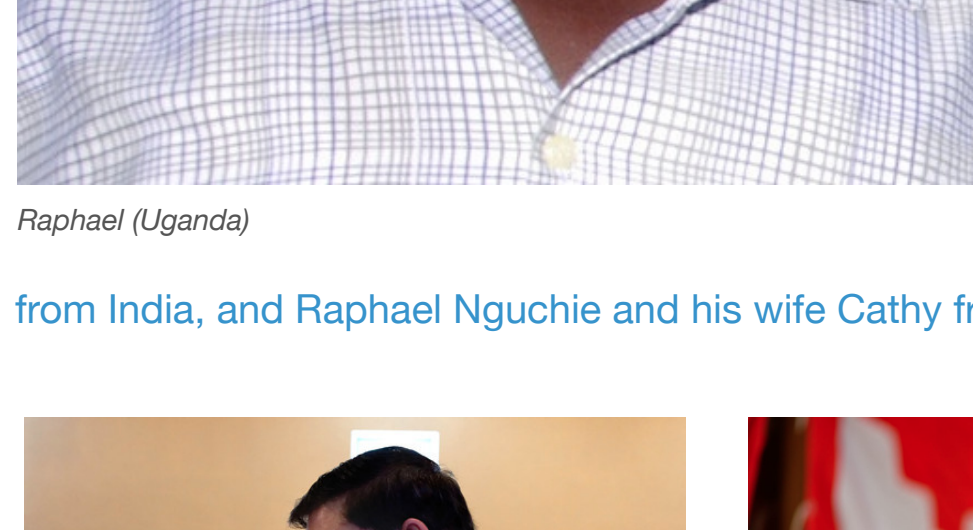
The Entire Village Greeted Us As We Arrived to Preach the Word of God

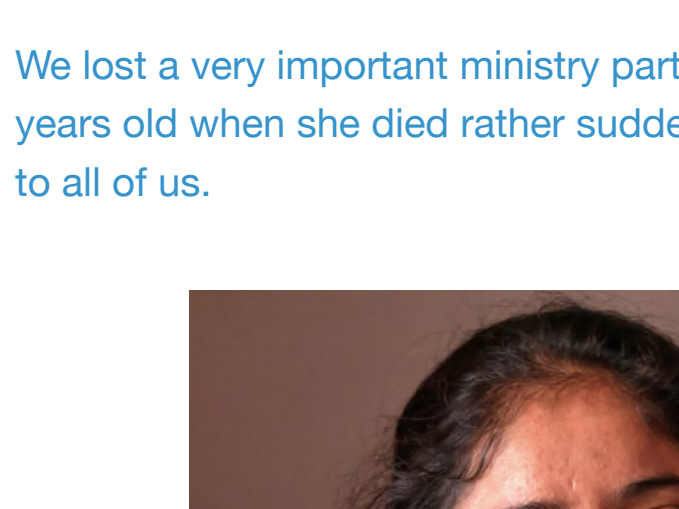
Our friend pastor Sorin Sarbu of Romania has taken some extra effort in the month of January reaching gypsies. You can read some details of his own report here.



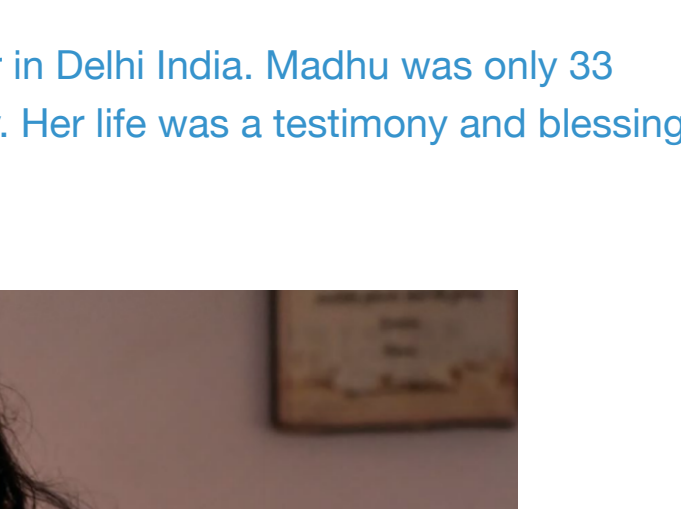
Raphael (Uganda)

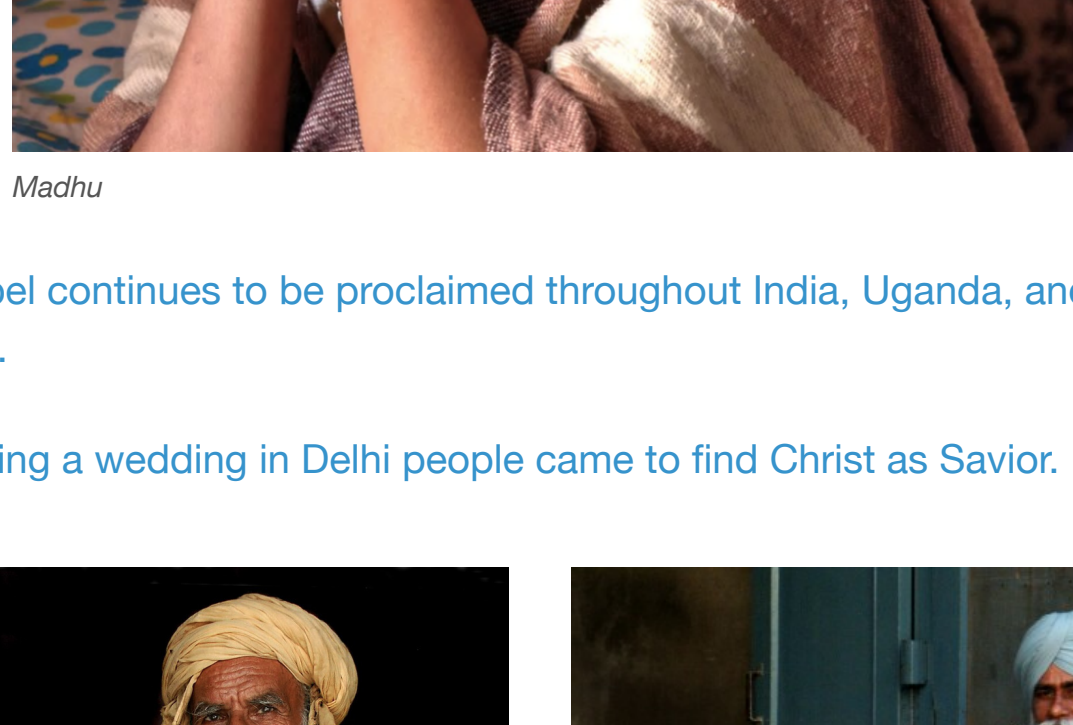
from India, and Raphael Nguchie and his wife Cathy from Uganda.

We lost a very important ministry partner in Delhi India. Madhu was only 33 years old when she died rather suddenly. Her life was a testimony and blessing to all of us.



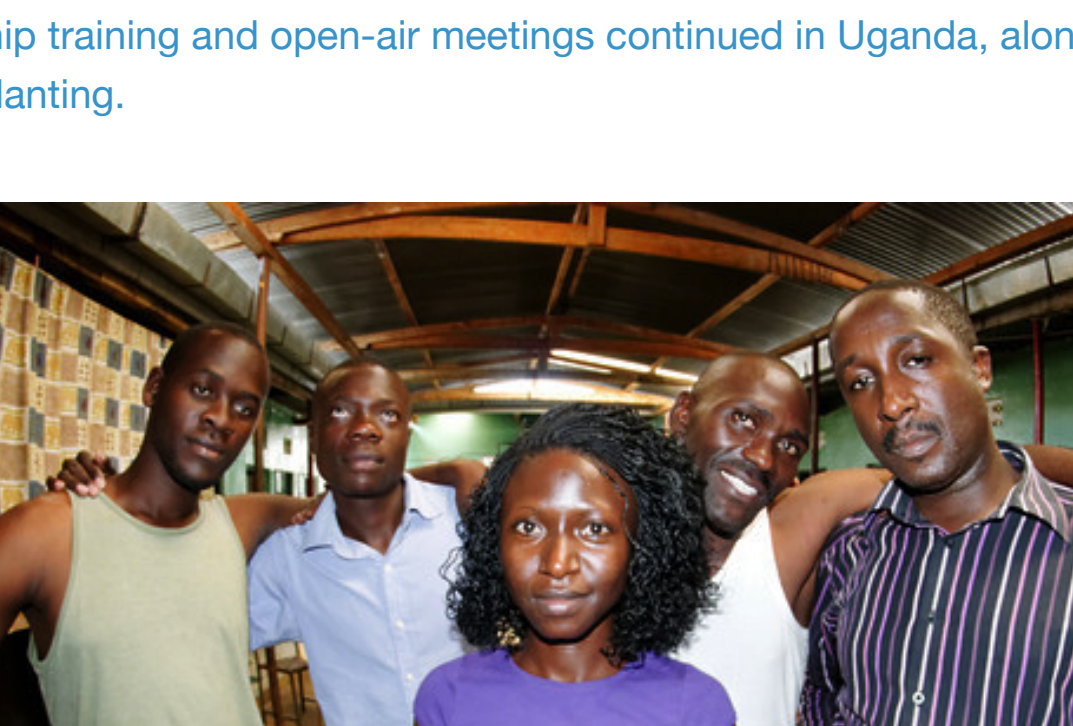

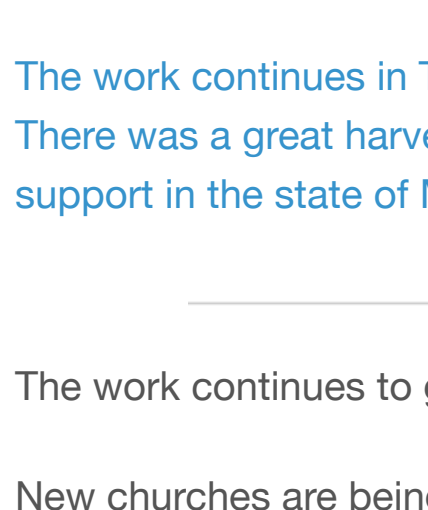


Baptism in the Nile River, Uganda

Leadership training and open-air meetings continued in Uganda, along with church planting.

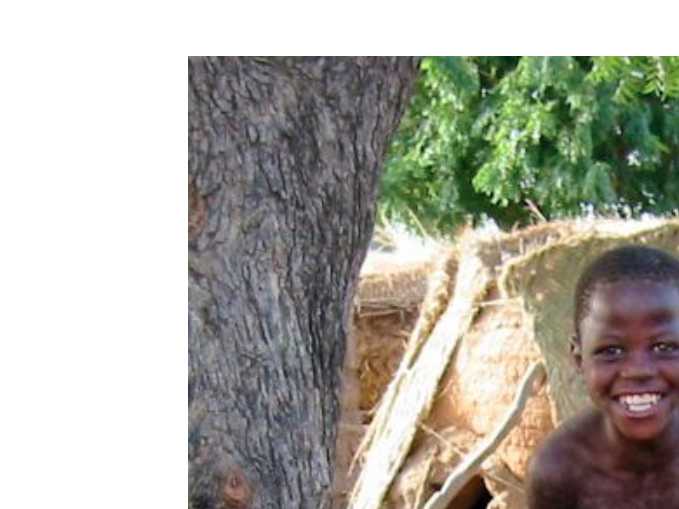


An Outreach Team in Uganda (Raphael On the Extreme Right)



Punjab

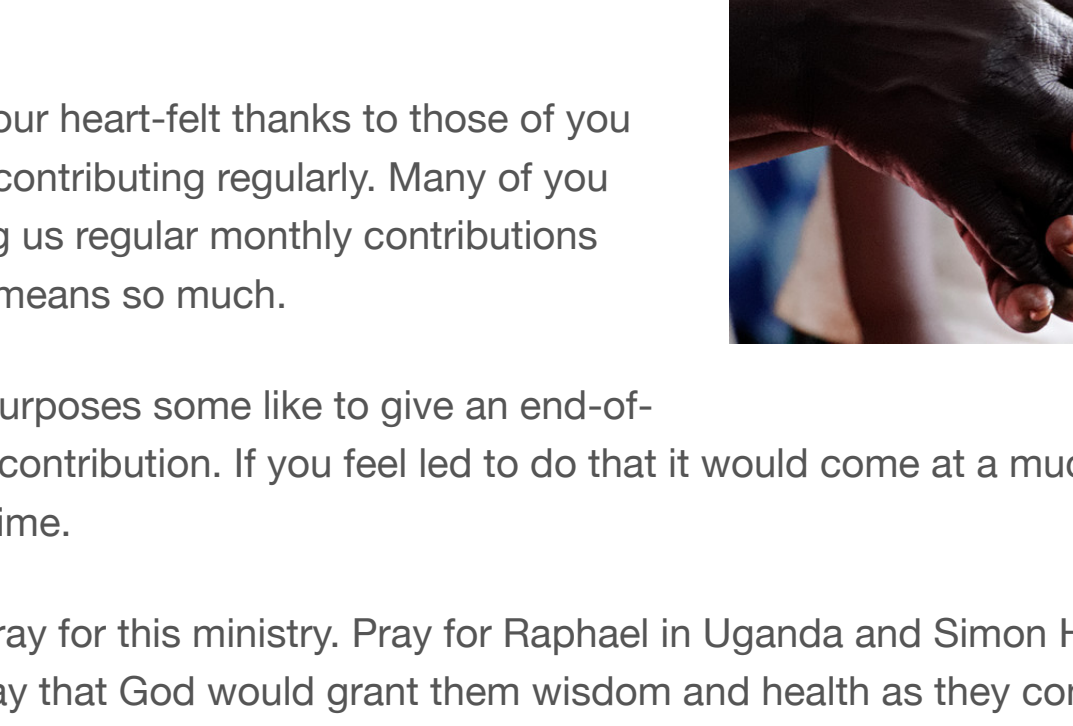
In Punjab, India there was a "feeding event" in Nagar Village where hundreds of people were given a free meal. Over 2,000 people gave their lives to Jesus Christ!

The work continues to grow strong.

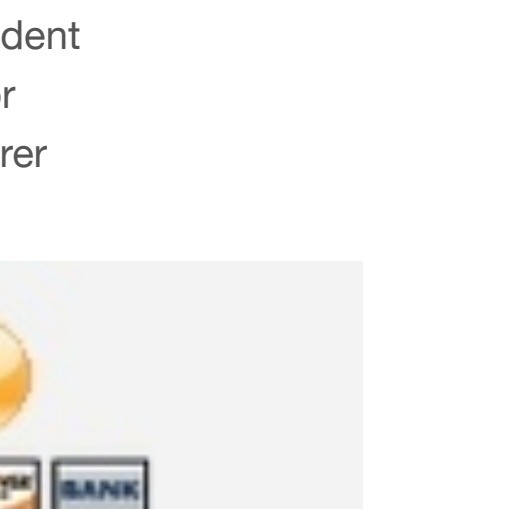

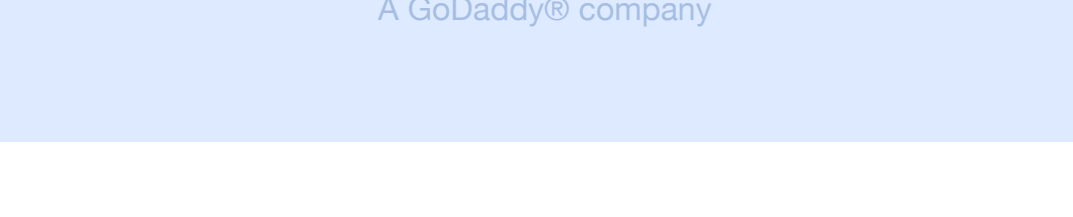
