The wedding was for one couple in our Pochieng church. They had been separated for 8 years but when they became born again through our church they reconciled.







They have been together now for a year. The testimony to me and then my joy in this is that after joining these two in Holy Matrimony, I had the joy of leading their 20 year old son to the Lord as he was overcome by the joy of the power of God to reconcile people.

He is now Born again!

We have received the following letter from our friend pastor Sorin Sarbu:

Blessings and Sincere Greetings to you brother Paul and to your supporters,

TWO PERSONS DECIDED TO BE BAPTIZED

I am very thankful of how God is working here in my Pastoral Ministry in this north-west of Romania. We have a joy to say that for this year we have already two persons that decided to be baptized:

We visited a couple of times an old man, named Gavrila, from Oncesti and shared with him the Gospel, but for long time he delay his decision to receive Christ, because he was an alcoholic. Soon after this Christmas season, he had a dream in which he drank some alcohol drink that was so bad, that he woke up, right after that dream, vomiting. In that night, he decided to follow Jesus. Pray for Gavrila (84 years old), because he will give his faith testimony, being baptized on 1th April. Praise God! (I found in my archive a picture with Gavrila and his wife on 2017 and attached)



Also, a young man, Petrica Moldovan, is from Sat Sugatag Church and he is attending my bible school class. His parents are not christians, and especially his dad is against his son to be baptized. Please pray for Petrica and his parents. Petrica will be baptized with God's help on 27 May and we are hoping that his decision will be followed by others from my Bible Study Class. At this moment I am making with him catechesis courses, helping him growing in his faith. (You can find Petrica in the picture with our bible class from Sat Sugatag. RECENT FINISHED PROJECTS

I was involved in a Charitable Project, by visiting old widows from Lapa and Sarasau and helping them by giving food supplies. Most of them are quite very poor and some are with health problems. Along with those food supplies we had the possibility to share God's Living Bread: Jesus Christ, and to some of them we gave them also a Bible.



Also in this February (5-9) was also had a special Training Week for Preachers and Leaders from Churches from Sighet and nearby. We already finished Attributes of God, Bible Theology, Hermeneutics, and now we had a new curriculum: Genesis. I realized that investing in equipping our preachers and leaders who are not able to go to a seminary, is a very

welcomed. About 13 people attended this training program. Pray for preachers and leaders from Romanian Churches!

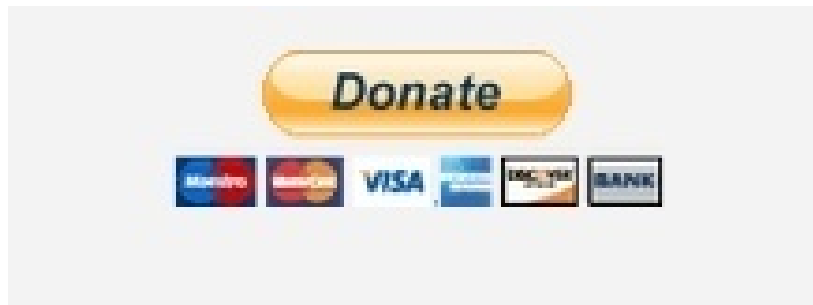
Brother Paul, I am really thankful for your passion and your time that you are investing in helping people of God all over the world. May God bless you and your ministry.
